## DORKING OVERVIEW




Dorking Station is the most northerly of the 3 stations on the map, with Dorking Deepdene Station just to its south and Dorking West Station off to the, er, west. Dorking Station has trains to Victoria and Waterloo, while the other 2 are on the Reading-Guildford-Redhill-Gatwick line.

To walk from Dorking Station, head out onto the main road and turn left, then turn right at the roundabout onto the High Street. Walk on the left side of the road and keep going on and on, continuing into South Street. After passing the Cricketers and the Queens Head, and continuing straight on at the junction of Horsham Road, take the next left into Falkland Road.

The 93 or 465 bus from the station will get you most of the way. You will need an Oyster card or contactless card for the 465. Look for the Queens Head on the left and alight at the next stop, which I think is named “Townfield Court”.

## ST JOSEPHS LOCATION



St Joseph's is in Falkland Grove which is the higher, narrower, road rising up to the left of Coldharbour Lane if you approach from the North
