ROUTE CARDS

*Apart from their interest and information for each day's walk, these route cards are your life-line in an emergency. **Carry them with you at all times.** (You may want to remove the staple and only carry the sheet you need each day). If you get separated from the main party, the route cards will tell you where we are going and indicate an outline of our route, and may help you locate any public transport, used in conjunction with the alternative transport list. It is a good idea to take a map case with you to keep your route cards in, together with leaflets and postcards etc that you may pick up at churches en route - even if you do not carry a map.*
