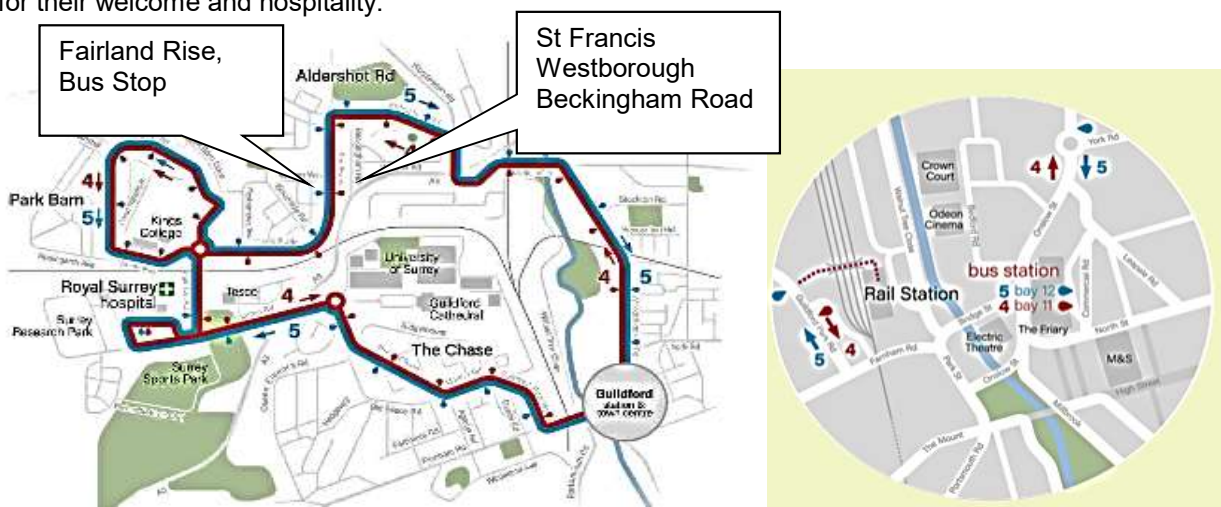

**A&B Pilgrimage History:** This is the pilgrims' first visit to St Francis, Westborough, with grateful thanks for their welcome and hospitality.



**Alternative Transport:**

**Friday May 3<sup>rd</sup>:** Guildford station is connected by a regular rail service (South West Railway) from London (Waterloo) or from Portsmouth. Direct connections also from Reading, Redhill and other local lines. The Friary bus station is also well served from more local areas. The overnight hall, St Francis, Beckingham Road, is about 1 mile (if you are a crow) from the station – nearest bus stop “Fairland Rise” in Southway served by route 4 from bus station or 5 the rail station. There is a footpath from Southway through to Beckingham Road. If walking from the station follow the bus route north west; at the roundabout, take the footpath north under the A3 & railway line, direct to Southway, then Beckingham Road.

**Saturday May 4<sup>th</sup>:** Guildford to Chiddingfold Route **71** from Guildford Friary bus station, Stand 3 (0920, hourly) direct to Chiddingfold, Crown Inn (51 minutes). For day pilgrims the **last bus** back to Guildford leaves at **1858**.

**Sunday May 5<sup>th</sup>:** Chiddingfold to Duncton There are *no bus routes* connecting to Duncton on a Sunday. Route 71 from Chiddingfold connects back to Guildford (1051, 1251, 1451, **1651**) or to Haslemere for railway station (1012, 1212, 1412, 1612, **1827**).

**Monday May 6<sup>th</sup>** (Bank Holiday): Duncton to Arundel No buses available on public holidays.

**From Arundel railway station** departures in the direction of London at approximately half-hour intervals (13 and 46 min past the hour). Trains to the south depart at 26 and 55 minutes past the hour.
