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DAY 2 **Saturday May 4** **Guildford to Chiddingfold** **14.6 miles**
Theme *The Word is Life*

For those staying overnight, our short walk to the Cathedral will bring it quickly into view to the left with its prominent location on Stag Hill although we lose sight of it again whilst crossing under the A3 and over the Woking direction railway lines. This Cathedral is one of two built during the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II - the other being "Paddy's Wigwam" (more formally the Metropolitan Cathedral of Christ the King, in Liverpool). We then descend the other side of the hill, cross all the railway tracks leading from the north side of Guildford station and quickly get to the River Wey. We follow this through the town centre stopping at St. Nicolas church (look for the marker indicating the extent of the 1968 flooding) and onwards along the Wey/Wey Navigation to our lunch stop at Farncombe. In the afternoon we leave the level ground along the Wey and move into the more rolling countryside of the Low Weald and the Surrey Hills AONB. We will pass through Winkworth Arboretum (toilets and café) and then make the ascent of Hydon's Ball which affords some fine views and was one of the first properties to be acquired by the National Trust. For anyone who walked with us in 2016, Chiddingfold was the lunch stop on the way from Hindhead to Cranleigh and the final mile of our walk today is the reverse of that route.

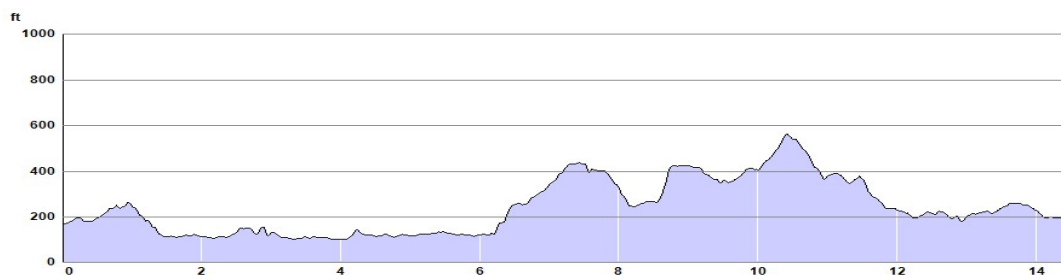
