**DAY 3      Sunday May 5      Chiddingfold to Duncton      15.2 miles**

**Theme**      *The Word is Life*

**Maps: L186 & L197 or OL33 & OL10**

After morning services in Chiddingfold, we leave its picturesque village south east, on footpaths through undulating wood and farmland and on country lanes. We walk past Shillinglee House (accidentally burnt down in the war by Canadian soldiers, but now restored) with views over The Lake, past the castellated Deer Tower and over China Bridge: echoes of Capability Brown. The bridleway eventually emerges from woodland with fine views over Northchapel. Cross the A283 (with care) to reach the pub and back and forth to St Michael's after lunch. The afternoon walk takes a footpath southwest to Crossways, where the aptly named "Blind Lane" meets Upperton Road. Beware, cars whizz along Blind Lane. We follow the quieter Upperton Road south to the gated entrance at Raghams Lodge and continue on a lane (public footpath) through the estate. We gather in Pheasants' Copse to go through Petworth Park, leaving by Upperton Gate for prayers at All Hallows, Tillington. Note the fine "crown" on the church tower of All Hallows, modelled on St Giles Cathedral in Edinburgh. The village hall, just before the church, will be opened for toilets. We leave All Hallows by the churchyard, cross the A272 (take care) and take a smugglers trail to the River Rother then up Kilsham Lane. We cross the busy A285 at the old railway (with great care) and walk on footpaths to Duncton.
