ROUTE TIMINGS v1.1

The Old Way Day Walks: as it says on the tin, a series of day walks. Participants must find their own way to the start point of each walk, and from the end point. They must book any accommodation they require themselves.

We will be walking as one group rather than following our traditional pilgrim system of front-markers, back-markers and orange marker arrows. Therefore we are not as confident of the accuracy of the timings as we are in a normal year. In particular, we cannot guarantee that we will reach the end of the walk at the stated time, and it would be unwise to make arrangements for the evening that are dependent on us being on-time.
