Who? - YOU!!!

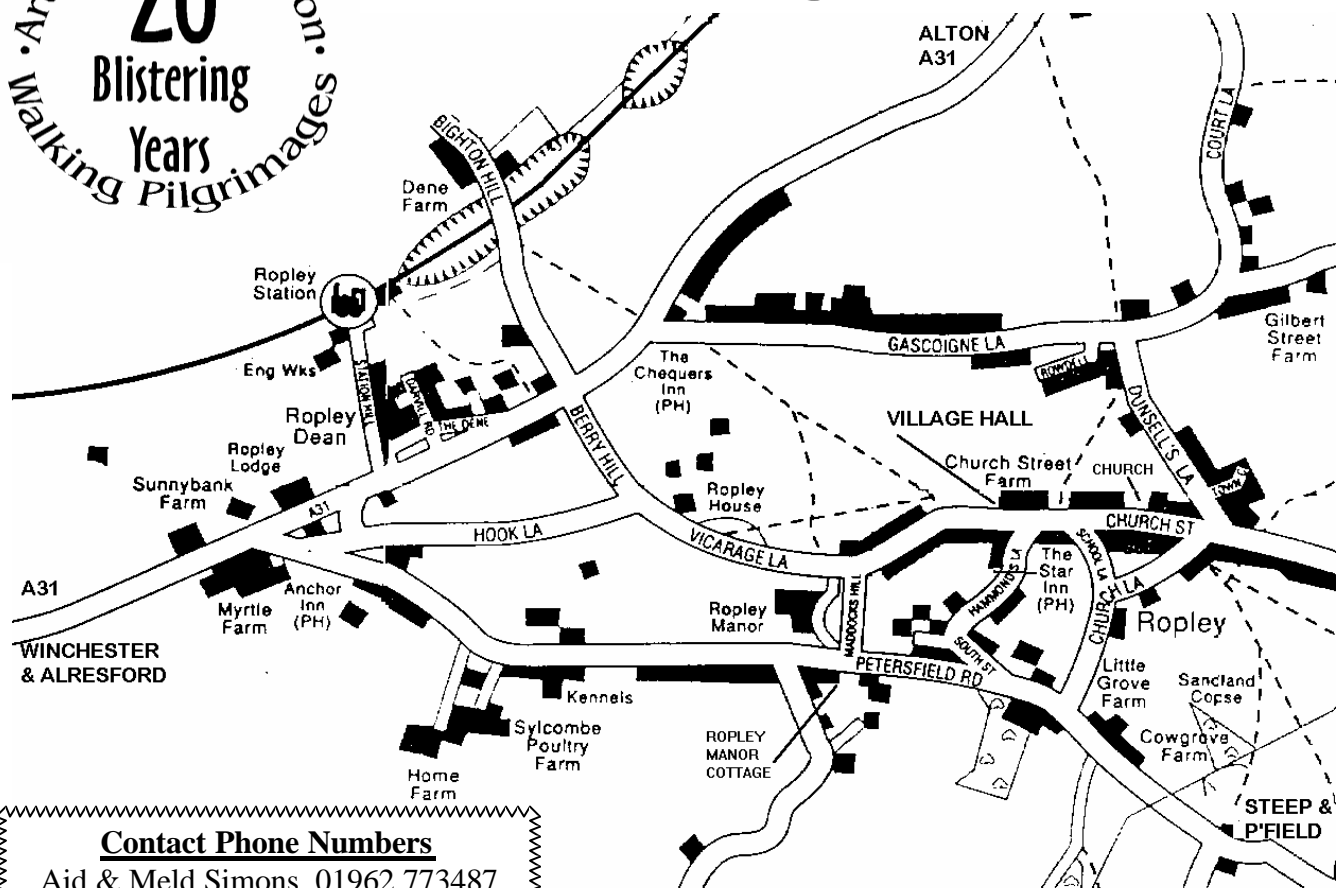

Can you give / do you need A LIFT

As we are rather out in the sticks, this would be an effective way of getting people here! If you fall into either category, please let us know and we will endeavour to match people up!

To reach us by Public Transport

Trains to Alton leave Waterloo, and stops include Clapham Junction and Woking. From Alton, the Winchester/Southampton buses run through Ropley on the A31. Timetable excerpts are given below: if you let us know when you expect to arrive we will try to meet the most popular trains. *Please make sure you return the booking form a.s.a.p. so that we can keep you informed of arrangements that we are able to make at this end.*

To Reach Us By Road

Bring your map! (any decent road map should show Ropley; it's on OS Landranger 185)

Ropley is on the A31 between Alton and Winchester. From the east, pass the Chequers pub then, after 300m, take the road on left signed "Church" and "School" on the left. From the west, pass the Shell garage and Anchor pub, after 1/2 mile take the above road (on your right). The village hall is on the left, about 1/2 mile up (phone box outside). From the north or south, come via Alton or Winchester as above, or from the south via Petersfield: take the road towards Steep from the Winchester road, cross A32, after nearly 3 miles turn right on road signed "recreation ground", right at the top, hall is 200 m on the left.
