2025 Jubilee Pilgrimage - Alternative Transport

Notes

- If pilgrims are unable to complete a day's walk or become detached from the main group, it is their responsibility to make their way to rejoin the pilgrims at a later stop or at the overnight location.
- To this end, pilgrims should carry a map (ideally OS 1:50k as identified on the Route Cards, or a road map of the local area).
- Mapping apps on smartphones can be useful, provided the phone is charged and there is network coverage. Google maps allows areas to be downloaded for offline use; other mapping apps require a subscription to allow this. Downloading should be done in advance!
- Google Maps offers public transport routes (when online) with walking connections, which is an effective way of completing your journey.
- Don't forget your railcard or bus pass if you have them.
- This document presents guidance on connections between locations visited by the pilgrimage actually timings should be verified on the day.
