Directions from Horley Station to the Catholic Church of the English Martyrs - a 15-20 minute walk

Come out of the front entrance of the station onto Victoria Road (this part of the station is on a bridge over the railway lines). Cross the road at the pedestrian crossing which is slightly to the right. Turn left and stay on the pavement on the right hand side of the road. The road bends to the right. At the junction with Consort Way East on the right, continue straight ahead via the pedestrian crossing. Carry straight on at the junction with Massetts Road on the left and the pedestrianised High Street on the right. Continue along the right hand side of Victoria Road, taking the zebra crossing over Consort Way and then cross 3 more side roads. Victoria Road then bends to the right. Cross another side turning and come to the junction with the A23 Brighton Road. Take the pedestrian crossing of the A23 and continue ahead into Vicarage Lane. Keep on the right hand side of Vicarage Lane as it bends to the right and you soon reach our destination on the right, a modern building with a separate bell tower.
