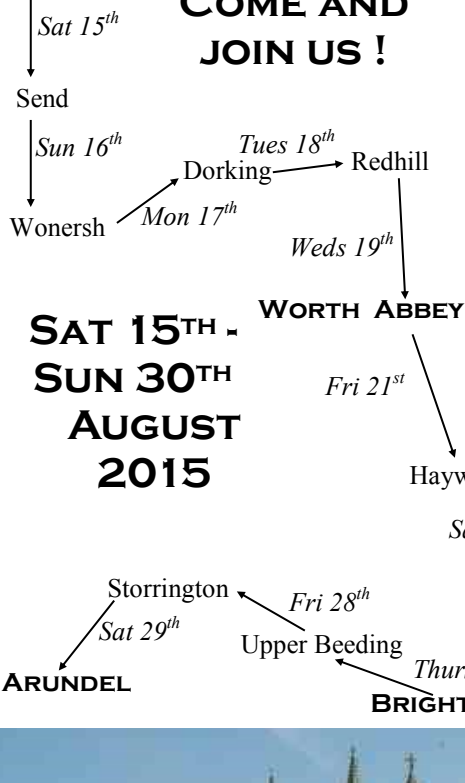




The Arundel Pilgrimage 2015

Walking in Faith & Fellowship

CHERTSEY



Each summer the Diocese of Arundel and Brighton organises an ecumenical walk to a cathedral city, shrine or area exploring a particular theme or aspect of our faith and Christian heritage. What we rediscover, year after year, is the amazing personal and community value of going on a pilgrimage as our medieval forebears did, where the journey, walking, laughing, sharing, praying and singing are as important as the destination. We picnic or stop at a pub for lunch and sleep on the floors of church, school or community halls. We try to walk on footpaths not roads.

In 2015 we are celebrating the 40th anniversary of the Walking Pilgrimage and the 50th anniversary of the Diocese of Arundel and Brighton, so we are returning to our roots, the communities of Surrey and Sussex, in thanksgiving and

prayer. As we walk from the abbey ruins at Chertsey through the towns and villages of the beautiful Surrey hills and along the Sussex coastline to Arundel we will be reflecting on Christian communities through the ages and asking what these can teach us about discipleship today.

Each day we worship together as an

ecumenical Christian community, journeying together and growing together in Christ-centred friendships. We stop to pray in the churches we pass, many of which are of architectural and historical interest, and all of which bring us into contact with the communities we are passing through.

TRANSPORT: Our luggage is carried by van. Pilgrims make their own way to the start in Chertsey and home from Arundel.

REQUIREMENTS: All you have to be is over 16 (or accompanied by an adult) and be fit enough to walk an average of about 15 miles per day at a moderate pace — and a sense of humour is useful.

COST: The cost is only £160 for the whole way (£100 for under 21's), £99 for one week or 1 to 6 nights at £15 per night. Breakfast, sandwiches for lunch and an evening meal are all included in the cost of the pilgrimage, which is organised by past pilgrims on a voluntary basis.
